The World's Best Hospitals 2026 ranking lists the best hospitals in 32 countries: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, India, Israel, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, the Netherlands, Norway, the Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Turkey, the United Arab Emirates, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America.

The countries were selected based on multiple comparability factors, such as standard of living/life expectancy, population size, number of hospitals, and data availability. *Newsweek* and *Statista* awarded the best hospitals based on four data sources:

- **Hospital Quality Metrics:** Medical indicators including data on quality of care for treatments, hygiene measures, patient safety, and waiting times.
- **Recommendations from Medical Experts:** Online survey among tens of thousands of doctors, health care professionals, and hospital managers in 32 countries.
- **Patient Experience:** Survey results measuring patient satisfaction with hospitalization.

- **Statista PROMs Implementation Survey:** Optional online survey on the implementation and use of Patient-Reported Outcome Measures in hospitals.

Based on the above four pillars and their respective weights, a final score was calculated for each hospital.

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
