List of signs of a bedbug infestation

Here are some clues that should make you suspect the presence of bedbugs :	
□ The person has been bitten and feels itchy	
>	The bites are similar to those of a mosquito and can cause small itchy red bumps.
	Some people do not show signs of bites, even if they have been bitten. If two people
	share a bed, it's possible that one of them has no bite signs while the other does.
>	The bites are mainly found on exposed parts of the arms, legs and back; bedbugs
	bite uncovered parts of the body. Bites that are present only on the lower part of the
	legs suggest the presence of fleas.
>	The bites can be in a straight line or grouped together on a same area of skin.
>	Bedbugs mostly bite at night. They tend to hide near the place they feed.
□ There	e are brownish or black stains on the sheets, pillows and mattress. The stains are caused by bedbug droppings and the blood of crushed bedbugs that have just fed.
☐ There are bedbugs, shed skin, droppings and/or eggshells in places where they like to hide. If it's the case, inspect these areas :	
>	Contours of the mattress and box spring
>	Floor cracks
>	Behind the frames
>	Peeling wallpaper.
