SPOTLIGHT ON CARE

Navigating the System: How to Get What You Need

What to do about a loss of autonomy

When faced with a loss of autonomy and/or changing medical needs, there are a wide range of services and levels of care available, ranging from home care to long term care.

In a loss of autonomy situation (a stroke, fracture or other situation which compromises a person's ability to care for themselves) an assessment is made – either at the hospital or through a request at the CLSC. Every effort will be made to keep an individual at home by offering home care services. The person's needs are determined by asking questions such as: How much assistance is required for daily living activities? Do they need 24 hour nursing services? Are any modifications needed in your home?

The social worker will fill out the proper forms requesting suitable home care services or accommodation based on the care required and the facility of choice. Once determined, the person is put on a waiting list. Wait times vary depending on the priority of each situation.

The continuum of care offered by CIUSSS West-Central Montreal

There are housing options, supervised by our CIUSSS, available for Montreal's seniors who are no longer able to live alone. Each option provides different levels of accommodation, care and support.

Short-Term Respite Stays

Caregivers may need a break from their responsibilities. Private rooms at Donald Berman Maimonides are designated for respite care for 2-4 week stays. Respite accommodations are accessed through a CLSC social worker.

Accredited Homes in the Community/ Intermediate Resources

Accredited Homes are supervised home-like living environments for seniors who require assistance with their activities of daily living. Accredited homes are often the first stop for seniors who can no longer care for themselves in their own home. A maximum of nine residents are accommodated per home; meals, laundry and assistance with personal

hygiene is provided and home-managers live on site.

Intermediate Resources are the next step in the continuum of care. We have partnerships with RI Lev-Tov, RI Manoir Renaissance, RI De la Montagne, Maison Paternelle, RI Cavendish and will soon be opening a new 96-bed RI at the corner of Jean-Talon and Cote-des-Neiges. They are ideal for people who do not require the higher level of care that is provided at DBM or DBJ.

Who decides when and where my family member is placed?

Donald Berman Maimonides (DBM) and Donald Berman Jewish Eldercare (DBJ) do not make any decisions regarding admissions. All decisions are made by a centralized admissions department within each health network. It is important to note that while DBM and DBJ are part of CIUSSS West-Central Montreal, regardless of where you live, you may request to be placed in an institution with a Jewish milieu. DBM and DBJ have Jewish mandates. Kosher meals are provided, Jewish holidays are observed and there is a Rabbi and synagogue on-site.

Follow-up should be made directly to the social worker who completed the initial evaluation. The social worker can be contacted for news about the application process.

How to prepare for admission?

It is important that the person who is moving is made aware of the impending admission, even if they are cognitively impaired. The family has only 24 hours to accept the space.

Monthly tours take place at DBM on the first Thursday of every month. At DBJ, group tours take place on the last Friday of every month. A visit can also be arranged to an Accredited Home or Intermediate Resource.

Sharing Expertise

Staff at DBM and DBJ as well as researchers from the Maimonides Centre for Research in Aging are working hard to keep our Centres at the forefront of innovation in patient-centred long-term care and aging research. The following list highlights some of their most recent achievements.

Presentations
