1.0 Minutes:

Dr. Chaytor proposed adoption of the minutes of the April 19th meeting, seconded by Dr. Papageorgiou; minutes accepted as presented.

2.0 Matters arising:

2.1 Predicting Discharge on Admission

According to Dr. Miner, the initiative of predicting discharge within 24 to 48 hours of admission was started in Psychiatry and one other unit. Apparently according to some recent research, completion of the exercise usually results in shorter hospitalizations because the team works towards the predicted discharge.

2.2 Contracts

Dr. Miner referred to the electronic version of the working document that she sent to the chiefs to be used as an example when developing contracts for the members of their department. Chiefs can determine their members' responsibilities and obligations to be used as a basis for providing privileges; this can vary from person to person. The

contract for the chiefs is different and has been developed by the Administration according to the old law. This old law states that the Administration can decide the status, obligations and privileges given to attending staff.

3.0 New Business:

3.1 Electronic charts in clinics

Dr. Miner noted legally a hospital should have only one type of patient chart kept in Medical Records. However there are many clinics that have their own chart which can be quite problematic when patients are seen and the information is not shared on CHARTMAXX. In order to alleviate this issue, there is an ongoing process to integrate an electronic record; all paper information from clinics will be scanned and sent to Medical Records.

3.2 Change from Medivisit to eRendez-vous

Dr. Miner noted that there will be a new appointment program under the Logibec option which encompasses the hospital's payroll and purchasing systems. Medivisit will gradually be replaced by eRendez-vous in all patient clinics.

3.3 Meeting with Dr. Bureau last week

Dr. Miner talked about a recent DPS meeting with Dr. Bureau; some of the subjects that were discussed include PL 130, the future role of DPS regarding PEMs, fin de carrière and demi-PEM, as well as recruitment of family physicians and anesthesiologists from France.

A brief discussion followed.

The meeting adjourned at 18:00.
