

JGH MEDICAL LIBRARY'S FIRST AUTOMATED CATALOGUE

We are pleased to announce that as of April 23rd, 1993 the Medical Library will have a computerized catalogue available to its users. This catalogue is another giant step in the automation of Medical Library services, which began in 1990 with the automation of serials management. This computerized catalogue will list the journals located in the Medical Library, the LDI Library, the ICFP Library and in the departments. Also listed are the monographs located at the Medical Library and the LDI Library. This project is being completed in stages. The first stage will include records for all journals and recent acquisitions as well as Medical Library monographs published later than 1980. By September of 1993 we will implement stage two which includes all our monographs dated 1970 to 1979. The final stage will cover the rest of the monographs. As early as fall of 1993 the HOPE & COPE Library will add their holdings to this catalogue. The Drazin memorial collection of Judaica and medical ethics will also be added to this catalogue in late 1993 or early 1994. This catalogue will be located in the computer room of the Medical Library (A-200).

By creating this catalogue and having it available to staff 24 hours a day we hope to increase the awareness of and availability of our collection.
