- Have it faxed to : 514-340-7547.

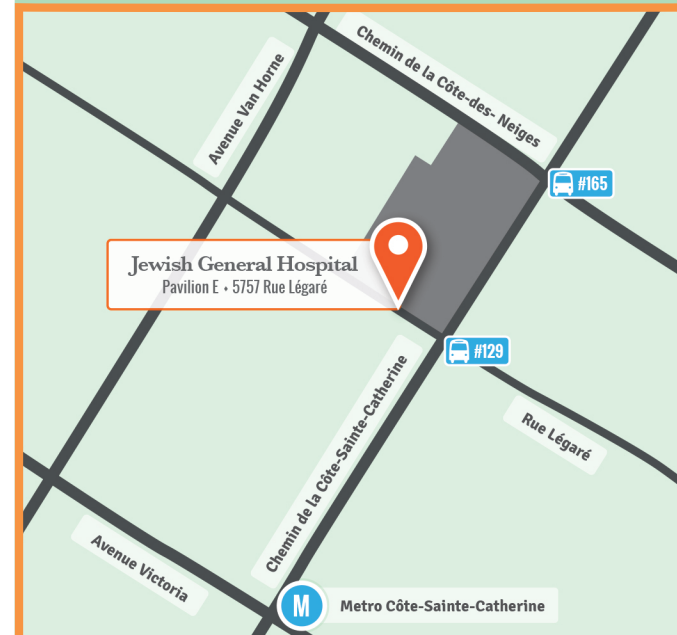
## How will I benefit?
