Users' 12 rights

The rights set out in the Act Respecting Health Services and Social Services

- 1. Right to information
- 2. Right to receive services
- 3. Right to choose a professional or institution
- 4. Right to receive appropriate care according to one's health status
- 5. Right to consent to care or to refuse care
- 6. Right to actively participate in decision-making
- 7. Right to be accompanied, assisted and represented
- 8. Right to shelter/accommodation
- 9. Right to receive services in English
- 10. Right to access one's User's file
- 11. Right to the confidentiality of one's User's file
- 12. Right to lodge a complaint

Other rights are recognized by the Quebec Charter of Human Rights and Freedoms and the Quebec Civil Code.
