Radiation for Vulvar Cancer

What is radiation therapy

"Radiation therapy uses high-energy rays or particles to destroy cancer cells. Radiation may be used for vulvar cancer:

- after surgery to destroy cancer cells left behind and to reduce the risk of the cancer recurring (adjuvant radiation therapy) in women who have positive lymph nodes in the groin
- before surgery, with or without chemotherapy, to shrink a tumour (neoadjuvant radiation therapy)
- as primary treatment for women who cannot have surgery because of health concerns
- to relieve pain or to control the symptoms of advanced vulvar cancer (palliative radiation therapy)

The amount of radiation given during treatment, and when and how it is given, will be different for each woman.

. . .

Vulvar cancer is usually treated with external beam radiation therapy. A machine directs radiation to the tumour and some of the surrounding tissue."
